I. Honoring Meta

- A. Colleen proposed that the Wool Growers Trial be held in honor of Meta.

- B. Donna will organize the 2026 Beebe Practice Day in honor of Meta as well, giving members two opportunities to participate in her remembrance.
- C. The board discussed incorporating a tribute to Meta at our 2026 demonstrations.
- D. An initial budget of \$300 was approved for the perpetual trophy.
- E. Meta's Oak Hill family has expressed interest in sponsoring an award; the board agreed they may wish to be included in the Wool Growers perpetual trophy.
